

Cookie Policy

Please read our policy on the use of cookies which forms part of our Terms.

Our Platform uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Platform. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Platform and also allows us to improve our Platform.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

1. We use the following cookies:

- 1.1. **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Platform. These essential cookies are always enabled because our Platform won't work properly without them. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our Platform, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services. You can switch off these cookies in your browser settings but you may then not be able to access all or parts of our Platform.
- 1.2. **Analytical or performance cookies.** These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Platform when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Platform works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- 1.3. **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our Platform. This enables us to personalize our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- 1.4. **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our Platform, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information to make our Platform and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose so that they can serve you with relevant advertising on their Platform.

3.1.4. Targeting cookies OFF

3.1.5. You can also choose to "Reject All" cookies in the cookie banner. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our Platform.
